### ***Please Don't Feed the Bears***

Dear Silver Shekel Property Owners,

The local bears are out of hibernation now. They are looking for food and one of the worst things we humans do is allow them to feed on our garbage. Leaving standard garbage cans and trash bags out overnight is an invitation to them. In addition to the mess that's behind, bears and garbage are a combination that can turn deadly for the bears. The Colorado Department of Parks and Wildlife gets too many calls that result in bears being put down, almost all of which are preventable.

Please do not put your standard garbage cans out overnight. Wait until the morning of pick-up. Timberline picks up on Wednesdays and Waste Management early on Thursdays.

Another very good solution is to use a garbage can that bears can't get into. One choice is the Toter 64 (\$229) available at Lowes (possibly) at Breckenridge Building Center.

If you can't avoid putting trash and garbage out the night before pick-up, please get these containers for your property. **This is especially important if you have short-term renters whose trash is sometimes left out for days.**
