Dear Silver Shekel Property Owners,

On Saturday, July 19th, we will have the annual Clean-up Day from 8:00 to 12:00.

This year we will have **two** roll-off dumpsters for use by our property owners. They will be centrally-located on the roadside at the intersection of Silver Circle and Shekel Lane, and will be placed there around 8:00 am. Dumpsters will be removed starting at noon.

- The dumpsters can be used to discard anything that can be placed into the Summit County landfill. **No hazardous waste** (such as tires, batteries, paint, petroleum products), **large appliances or electronics** (TVs, computers, printers, scanners, etc.) will be allowed in any of the dumpsters.
- If you have normal recyclables, please take them to the Summit County Recycling drop-off on Coyne Valley Road or at County Commons in Frisco.
- The County will accept household hazardous waste, electronics and appliances at **no charge** for County residents at the Summit County Resource Allocation Park (SCRAP) site near Keystone. Click here for hours, directions and more info.
- Refrigerators must either be (1) hauled to the Summit County landfill after having the coolant professionally drained, or (2) removed by Xcel Energy. Xcel will haul off working units and even give you a \$50 rebate! Click for details.
- Tree trimmings and other slash will be allowed in the dumpsters after 11:00 am.

Clean-up Day is open to all our property owners in good standing. If you haven't paid your dues this year, we'll accept your check at the dumpsters.

Please take the opportunity to police the right-of-way next to the road along your property and clean up debris that may have accumulated over the winter. Thank you!
