A Few Reminders

Dear Silver Shekel Property Owners,

We have a number of new residents in the neighborhood and this seems like a good time to remind all of us of a few things that can make living in Silver Shekel more enjoyable for all:

1. Dogs must be on leash or under competent voice command, per County ordinance. This is important because we have a lot of people that walk our streets, some with and others without their own dogs.
2. Please pick up after your dogs.
3. Trash bins should not be left on the street except on the day of trash pickup. Bring them to your house or garage.
4. Per County ordinance parking on our roads, shoulders and easements is not allowed. It can be dangerous, especially when the streets are snow-packed. Illegally parked cars impede the county snow plows and can make it difficult for neighbors to get out of their driveways.
